A message from the CI:

Dear All, Great news!!!

NIHR that we have been granted an extension to allow us to complete Sunflower recruitment. Also, we have recalculated the target number which is now **7,457**, down from the original number of 13,680. Currently we have recruited **6,341**.

In summary we now have until **June 2024** to recruit a further **1,152** patients. This is very possible!! Everybody including our new sites need to produce one last drive to get over the line!

What has changed with the Sunflower extension?



This is a reminder that the recent decision to extend the Sunflower study does not have any impact on or changes to study conduct.

However, please ensure you have the up-to-date versions* of

- 1. Protocol version 7.0
- 2. PIL version 8.0 this needs to be localised and returned to us asap
- 3. Manual version 5.0
- *All new versions are in the TMF on the Sunflower TMS

Abandoned surgeries and documentation

We recently added a new field to the surgical forms to allow teams to document abandoned surgeries. If you are entering these into the database and the patient may come in for another lap chole attempt on a future date, please ensure you leave the C2 form blank and add the abandoned surgery on the new C2X form. This allows us to monitor who are due future lap choles. Thanks! For all queries on these cases, do get in touch.



Associate PI Scheme



Trainees are crucial for recruitment to the Sunflower Study - thank you to all those involved so far and do continue to galvanise engagement with the study!
